### JISCTS

- That Credit Transfer is an important parameter for the modern teaching learning system as it ensures transparencies, Mobility, Comparability and Quality and Coherence.

Advantage of Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and Credit Transfer System (CTS).

- a) Enhancement of learning opportunities
- b) Ability to match learners scholastic need and operation.
- c) Inter Institutional Transferability
- d) Part Completion of an academic programme in the Institution of Enrolment and Part Completion in a Specialized Institutes
- e) Shift in focus from teacher centric to learner centric education.

- **To implement at the Institutional level following things are to be done:**

- a) Programme wise catalogue should be prepared in detail for all academic programmes offered by the institution. Apart from basic information regarding (i) admission procedure (ii) fees to be paid (iii) eligibility (iv) academic calendar and overall programme structures each catalogue should contain other details like course of choices , coursewise syllabus, coursewise learning outcome (what learners are expected to know, understand and be able to do after studying a given course) expressed in terms of credit.
- b) The programme wise catalogue thus prepared should be published in print form and made available on the website.
- c) In addition to the programme wise catalogues certain other key documents are required
  - i) Learning agreement

- ii) Transcript of Records in order to assist the process of credit accumulation and Credit Transfer from one programme to another (Internal) or from one institution to another (External).
- When the three parties is the learner, home institution and host Institution agree about offering credit transfer facilities for a certain academic programme they should sign a learning agreement which should be attached to an application form submitted by the learner.
- Such a learning agreement specific that learner agrees to undertake the programme of study at another host institution as an integral part of his / her higher education. The home institution according to this agreement will also provides as assurance to the learner that the home institution will give full academic recognition in respect to the courses listed in the agreed.
- Transcript of record should describe the learning achievements of the concerned learner prior to and after the period of study in another institution.

### **Rules & Regulations**

#### **Interdisciplinary Credit Transfer (ICT)**

- (i) **Full credit transfer and change of stream in a particular discipline would be allowed if the syllabus and methodology now in vogue are similar to that governing the student under the old enrolment and as per credit transfer rules framed by the JISCTS. However the facility of credit transfer shall be allowed only after the application is scrutinized by the Credit Transfer Committee of JISCE and all details furnished are found to be correct.**
- (ii) In order to be eligible for internal credit transfer a student has to score  $\geq 8.5$  in YGPA under the Old Enrolment

- (iii) ICT will applicable only once after completion of the two semesters of 1<sup>st</sup> Year under the old enrolment
- (iv) Once a student takes fresh admission new enrolment , it will be valid for another 8 years. The student is required to complete all the requirements under the new enrolment for the award of Degree of BTech during this time period, In case such a student wishes to pursue the programme further, s/he will have to do all the courses afresh as no credit transfer facility will be applicable any further.
- (v) No fees will be charged to avail ICT facility.
- (vi) Registration /Re-registration rules as given in the Student Handbook & Prospectus would remain unchanged even for completing the left-over courses under new Enrolment. As usual the Registration/Re-registration Form is to be submitted at the University concerned.
- (vii) All Credit transfer cases would be directly handled by Student Registration Division (SRD) at COE Section JISCE
