Notification in respect of student admitted in AY 2025-26 and onward

After detailed discussion with the stakeholders and approval of the competent authority, the following are notified for information of all concerned in respect of the autonomous students [UG (B.Tech.), BBA, BBA-DM, BBA-HM, BCA and PG (M.Tech., MBA and MCA)] admitted in AY 2025-26 (R25 - Regulation) and onward.

1. Minimum Passing Marks:

- THEORY subject** - Students must secure a minimum of 40 marks in total in combined score of CIE and SEE.
- PRACTICAL subject** - Students must secure a minimum of 50 marks in total in combined score of CIE and SEE.
- SESSIONAL subject** - Students must secure a minimum of a total 50 marks out of 100.

3. Semester End Examination Marks:

End Semester examination for all theory courses are of 60 Marks.

Marks distribution in SEE Questions (for UG programme, BBA, BCA and PG programme - MBA and MCA)

- Group A:** Multiple Choice Question (Total Marks: 10) - Students have to attempt TEN questions out of TWELVE questions – Each question should be of 1 mark.
- Group B:** Short Answer Type Question (Total Marks: 20) - Students have to attempt FOUR questions out of SIX questions – Each question should be of 5 marks.
- Group C:** Long Answer Type Question (Total Marks: 30) - Students have to attempt THREE questions out of FIVE questions – Each question should be of 10 marks.



Marks distribution in SEE Questions (for PG-M.Tech. programme)

Long Answer Type Question (Total Marks: 60) – Students have to attempt FIVE questions out of SEVEN questions – Each question should be of 12 marks.

End Semester examination for all practical courses are of 60 Marks.

Each practical/laboratory item ordinarily evaluated in the presence of an external examiner & the course teacher jointly.
